**What is the composition of the U-SU Board?**

The U-SU Board is composed of 13 voting members and variable non-voting members. Student representation on the U-SU Board is recommended by the Associated Students, Incorporated (A.S.I.) of California State University, Los Angeles with a simple majority consent of the BOD. You may use this application to apply for the following position(s):

- Chair (student position that has served on the U-SU Board for two quarters)
- Vice Chair (student position that has served on the U-SU Board for one quarter)
- 7 Student Members

**What is the University-Student Union Board of Directors (U-SU Board)?**

The University-Student Union Board establishes governance and policies. Primarily through its standing committees, this body reviews and develops policies that govern the University-Student Union. Reporting to the Board of Directors are four committees: Fiscal, Personnel, SABU (Space Allocation and Building Utilization), and PASS (Programs and Student Services). All committees are chaired by student board members.

**\_\_\_\_\_ Fiscal Committee:**

- o Consists of 7 members (3 must be student members)
- o Responsible for recommending fiscal matters to the U-SU Board
- o Approves budget process

**\_\_\_\_\_ Personnel Committee:**

- o Consists of 7 members (5 voting board members, 2 non-voting)
- o Responsible for developing and recommending personnel policies
- o Conducts the evaluation of the U-SU Executive Director

**\_\_\_\_\_ S.A.B.U. (Space Allocation and Building Use) Committee:**

- o Consists of 7 members (at least 4 student members)
- o Recommends policies regarding use of U-SU facilities
- o Decides how to best utilize U-SU space

**\_\_\_\_\_ P.A.S.S. (Programs and Student Services) Committee:**

- o Consist of 7 members (at least 4 student members)
- o Develops and recommends presentation and provision of events and student services.
- o Evaluate the effectiveness of programs/services and participate in planning of major events.

All positions require students to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. In addition, undergraduate student nominees must have been enrolled at CSULA for one year and have earned no fewer than eighteen (18) quarter units of academic credit during that year. Graduate student nominees must earn eight (8) quarter units of academic credit per quarter of continuous attendance as a new graduate student to be eligible. New graduate students who received a bachelor’s degree or credential within the past three years from CSULA must have earned a total of 12 units during their last year as an undergraduate student to be eligible.

Responsibilities of University-Student Union Board of Directors include:

1. Actively seeking out the opinions, needs, and desires of the student body at large.
2. Chairing and/or serving on at least one standing committee.
3. Performing other tasks as requested by the Board of Directors.
4. Actively participating in University-Student Union activities and programs.

University-Student Union Board of Directors should anticipate spending approximately 10 – 15 hours per month on Board activities including meetings.

Note: All recommendations for appointments to the University-Student Union of Directors are made by the Associated Students, Inc.
